Birth

The Public Health, Office of Vital Records registers live births that occur in Riverside County. They maintain all birth certificates that occurred within the current year and previous year only. Birth certificates are typically available for purchase within 10 days after birth.

Two types of records are available: Authorized and Informational. Authorized copies are available only to select individuals. All others may purchase an Informational copy. An Informational copy is not accepted for legal purposes.

For non-hospital births that occurred in Riverside County, contact the Public Health, Office of Vital Records at (951) 358-5068.



The Riverside County Clerk-Recorder receives copies of all live births that occurred in Riverside County from the Health Department. They maintain all Riverside County birth records permanently from 1893 to present. For all other records, you must contact the county in which the birth occurred. Birth certificate copies are typically available for purchase 4-6 weeks after birth.

Two types of records are available: Authorized and Informational. Authorized copies are available only to select individuals. All others may purchase an Informational copy. An Informational copy is not accepted for legal purposes.

(Only the mother or father is eligible to request a certified Certificate of Still Birth)



The Public Health, Office of Vital Records registers deaths that occur in Riverside County. They maintain all deaths that occurred within the current year and previous year only. Death certificates are typically available for purchase within 8 days after death.

Two types of records are available: Authorized and Informational. Authorized copies are available only to select individuals. All others may purchase an Informational copy. An Informational copy is not accepted for legal purposes.

Two types of records are available: Authorized and Informational. Authorized copies are available only to select individuals. All others may purchase an Informational copy. An Informational copy is not accepted for legal purposes.

The Riverside County Clerk-Recorder issues marriage certificates for marriage licenses that were purchased in Riverside County since 1893 to present. For all other marriages you must contact the county in which the marriage license was issued. Marriage Certificates are typically available within two weeks of the marriage.

Two types of records are available: Authorized and Informational. Authorized copies are available only to select individuals. All others may purchase an Informational copy. An Informational copy is not acceptable for legal purposes.

Confidential Marriage Certificates are only available to the parties of the confidential marriage or person designated by order of the Superior Court.
